

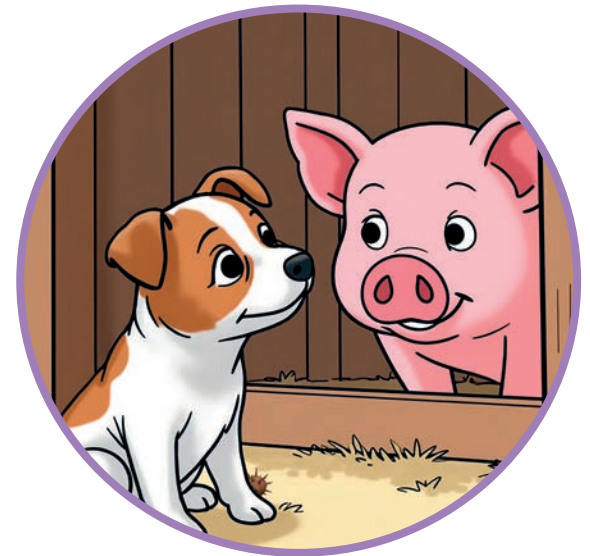

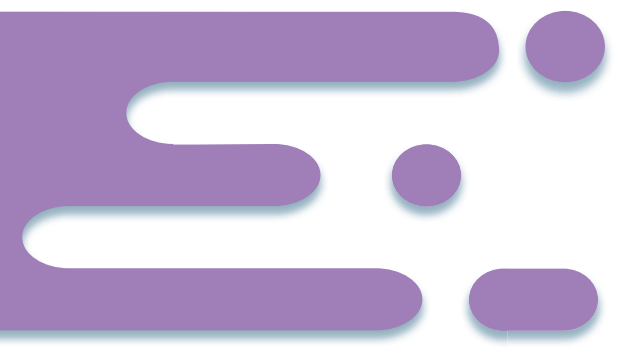

And a nice juicy bone.



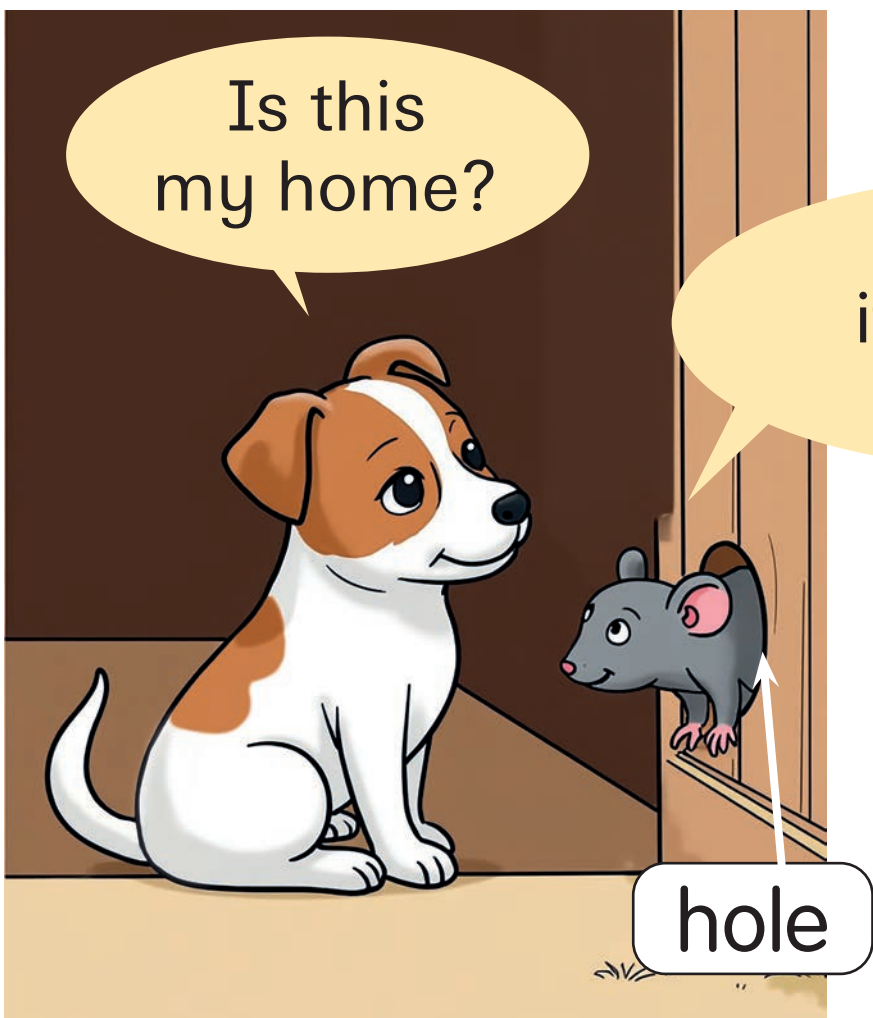
Jojo was lost.



He saw a cow.

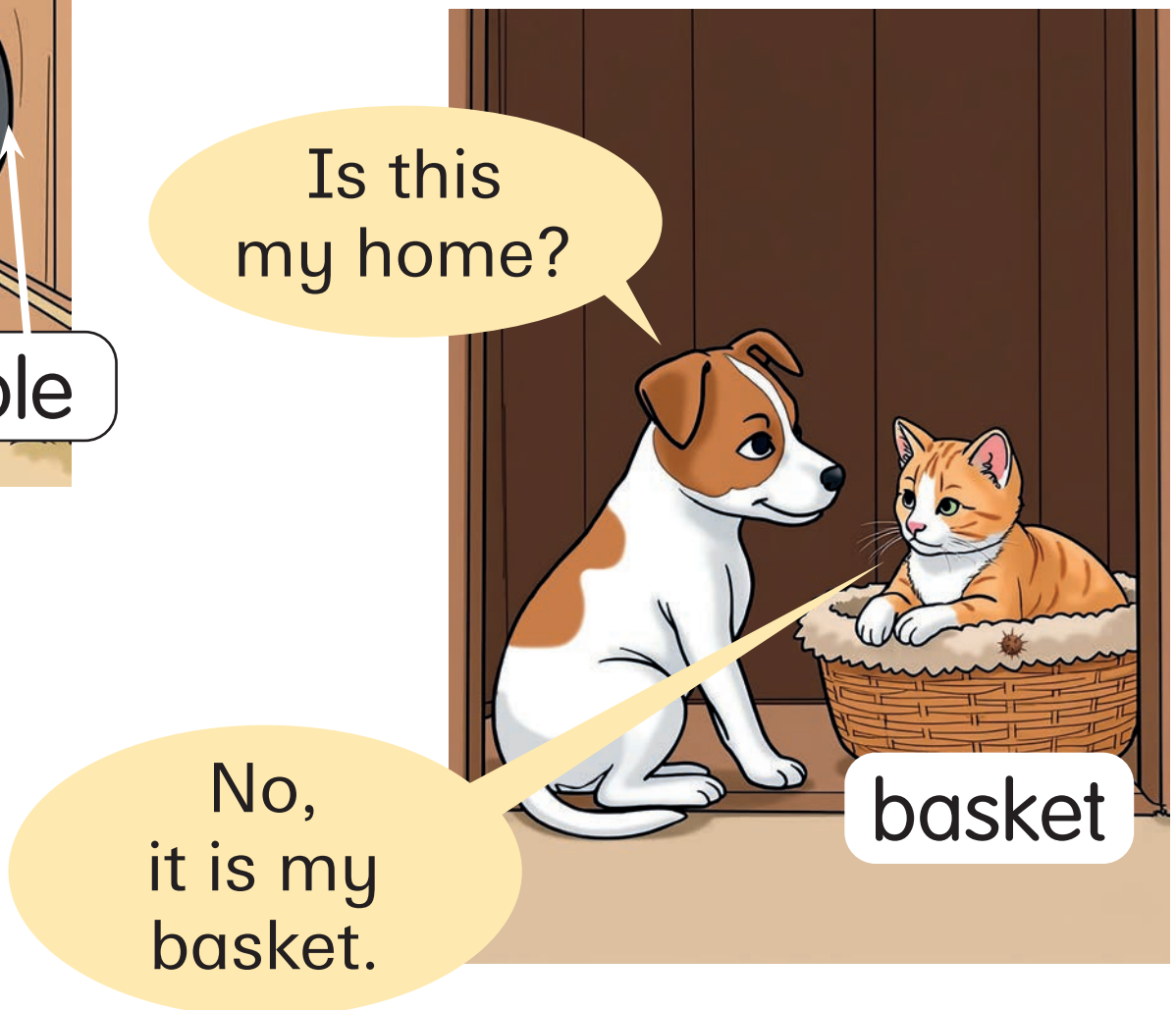


He saw a mouse.

it is mine.

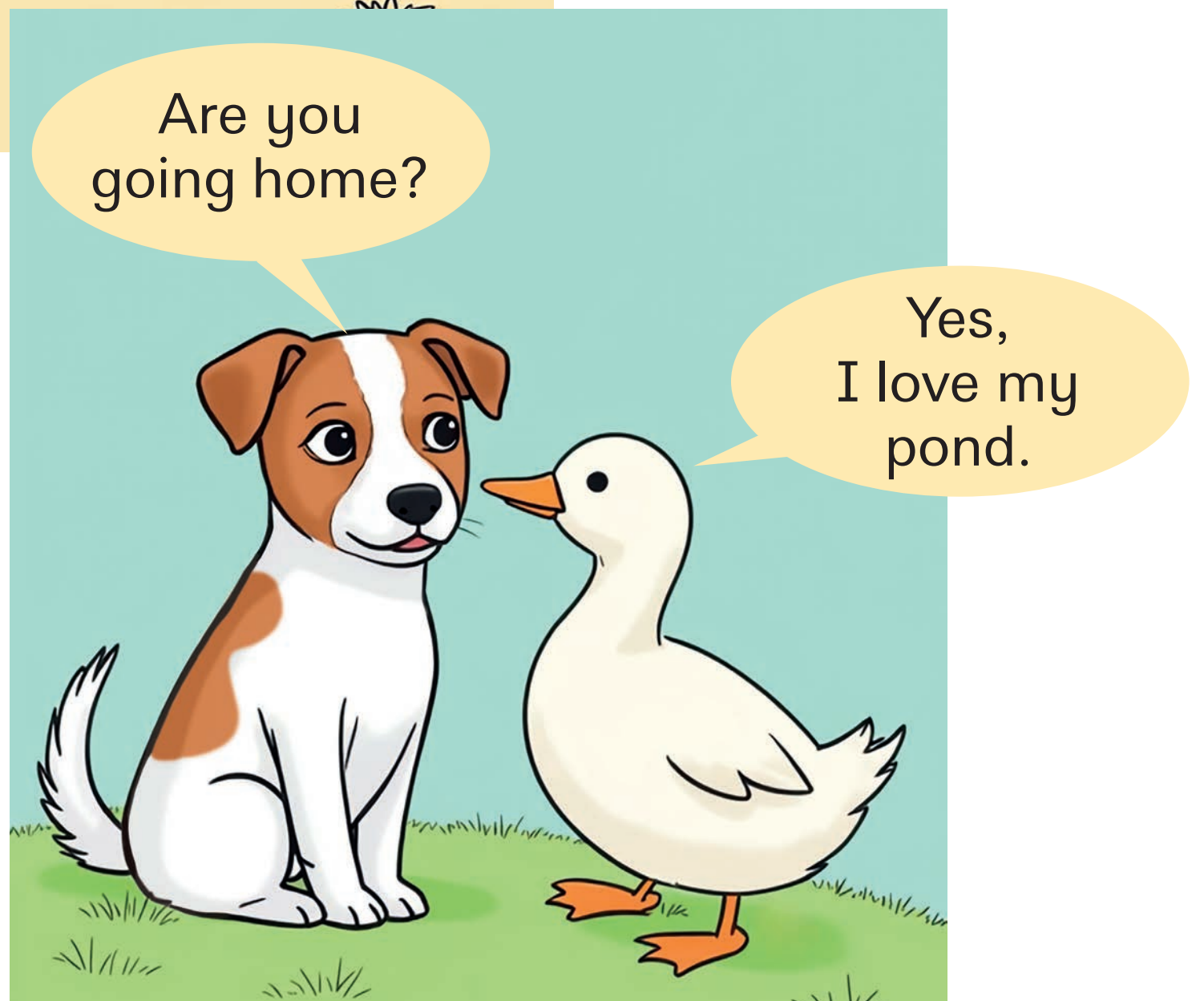
Jojo saw
